**CEC31 Resolution Regarding the Zoning Line Proposal Submission for P.S. 5
This resolution was unanimously approved at the November CEC 31 Calendar
Meeting, with 9 members voting Yes and 0 members voting No.**

WHEREAS, Community Education Council 31, in accordance with Chancellor's Regulation A-185, applicable Federal, State and City Law, Regulations of the New York State Commissioner of Education and policies of the New York City Public Schools (NYCPS); and

WHEREAS, a zoning line proposal for P.S. 5 in District 31 has been submitted to CEC 31 on October 28th, 2024 by the NYCPS Office of District Planning for Brooklyn North and Staten Island; and

WHEREAS, NYCPS proposed zoning changes for P.S. 5 in order to:

- a. Re-draw P.S. 5, P.S. 3, and P.S. 36 zone lines to account for the new school building addition at P.S. 5; and
- b. Ensure appropriate enrollment and utilization across the three schools; and
- c. Aim for each school to have space to accommodate its zone.

WHEREAS, effective date for implementation is the 2025-2026 school year; and

WHEREAS, Community Education Council 31 has reached out to the impacted communities by means of multiple:meetings, School Leadership Team meetings, electronic communications, digital surveys; and

WHEREAS, CEC 31 has worked collaboratively with the NYCPS in an effort to accommodate the needs of the impacted schools; and

WHEREAS:

- a. Addresses contained in the following area would be included in the new P.S. 5 zone:
 1. Start at the intersection of Korean War Veteran's Parkway and Foster Road, then
 2. South on Foster Road to Drumgoole Road East, then
 3. South on Foster Road to Amboy Road (excluding both sides of the street), then
 4. Southwest on Amboy Road to Seguire Ave, then
 5. South on Seguire Avenue to Johanna Lane, then
 6. West on Johanna Lane (including both sides of the street) and, where Johanna Lane turns South, continuing West to Lemon Creek, then
 7. South, following Lemon Creek, to Hylan Boulevard, then
 8. South, following Lemon Creek, to the Raritan Bay waterfront, then

9. Southeast along the water and continuing Northeast along the water to Holdridge Avenue, then
10. Northwest on Holdridge Ave to Koch Boulevard and continuing through Blue Heron Park to Amboy Road where it intersects with Seguine Place, then
11. West on Amboy Road to Blue Heron Court, then
12. South on Blue Heron Court (excluding both sides of the street as both sides of Blue Heron Court are in the P.S. 55 zone), then
13. North on Blue Heron Court back to Amboy Road, then
14. West on Amboy Road to Annadale Road, then
15. Northeast on Annadale Road to Furman Street (including both sides of the street), then
16. Northeast on Annadale Road to Staten Island Railroad, then
17. West, following the Staten Island Railroad, to Lexa Place, then
18. North to Korean War Veterans Parkway, then
19. West on Korean War Veterans Parkway to Foster Road (the point of origin).

b. The addresses contained in the following area would be in the new P.S. 3 School zone:

1. Start at the intersection of Korean War Veterans Parkway and Foster Road, then
2. South on Foster Road to Drumgoole Road East, then
3. South on Foster Road to Amboy Road (including both sides of the street), then
4. Southwest on Amboy Road to Seguine Avenue, then
5. South on Seguine Avenue to Johanna Lane, then
6. West on Johanna Lane (excluding both sides of the street) and, where Johanna Lane turns South, continuing West to Lemon Creek, then
7. South, following Lemon Creek, to Hylan Boulevard, then
8. South, following Lemon Creek, to the Raritan Bay waterfront, then
9. West along the water to Richard Avenue, then
10. North on Richard Ave (excluding both sides of the street) and continuing along Eastern border of Long Pond Park to intersection of Amboy Road and Richmond Valley Road, then
11. Northeast to Emerald Court, then
12. North on Emerald Court to Station Avenue (including both sides of the street), then
13. North on South Service Road to Bloomingdale Road (including both sides of the street), then
14. North on Bloomingdale Road to Korean War Veterans Parkway (including both sides of the street), then
15. East on Korean War Veterans Parkway to Foster Road (the point of origin)

1. Start at the intersection of Foster Road and Korean War Veterans Parkway, then
2. East on Korean War Veteran Parkway to Delmar Avenue, then
3. South to Staten Island Railroad, then
4. East, following the Staten Island Railroad to Arden Avenue, then
5. Northwest on Arden Avenue to Annadale Road (excluding both sides of the street), then
6. North on Annadale Road to Drumgoole Road East (excluding both sides of the street), then
7. North on Annadale Avenue to Drumgoole Road West, then
8. North on Annadale Avenue to Forrestal Avenue (excluding both sides of the street), then
9. West on Forrestal Avenue (including both sides of the street) and, where Forrestal Avenue turns south, continuing West to Alexander Ave, then
10. West on Alexander Avenue to Woodrow Road (including both sides of the street), then
11. Southwest on Woodrow Road to Grantwood Avenue, then
12. Southwest on Woodrow Road to Row Place (excluding both sides of the street), then
13. Southwest on Woodrow Road to Carlton Boulevard, then
14. Southwest on Woodrow Road to Vineland Avenue (excluding both sides of the street), then
